## WHITE WINES *By the bottle*

**Maison Bellenger White** £31

*France* | This wine is from the South of France and made from a blend of two grape varieties: Colombard and Ugni Blanc. A light bodied wine with floral aromas, and flavours of lemon and grapefruit.

**Santa Rita Gran Hacienda Chardonnay** £37.5

*Chile* | This Chardonnay is made with grapes from a variety of vineyards within Chile Central Valley. This variety of vineyards produce a wine with ripe tropical fruit with lots of freshness and is medium bodied.

**Alois Lageder Riff Pinot Grigio** £40

*Italy* | Light, refreshing wines with flavours and aromas of citrus fruit and a hint of green apple. A well-made Pinot Grigio, this wine has the usual clean, crisp flavours of green apples and citrus fruits.

**Domaine Felines Jourdan Cuvee** £42.5

**Classique Picpoul de Pinet**

*France* | 100% Picpoul grapes. The wines stay on the lees for 6 months and here they build their capacity to age for 5 years. The wine has beautiful aromas.

**Journey's End Weather Station** £45

**Sauvignon Blanc**

*South Africa* | The aromas are pungent and intense with flavours of ripe tropical fruit. The wine flavours remain for a long time cleaning the palate with its crisp refreshing acidity.

**Mount Langi Ghiran Billi Billi Riesling** £50

*Australia* | The Riesling grape is capable of making some great, clean and fruity wine. This wine is bright and refreshing and has intense flavours of lemon grass, lime and cherry blossom.

**Bodegas Castro Martin A2O Albarino** £55

*Spain* | Albarino is the name of the grape used to make this wine which is native to Spain. It makes a light, crisp and flavourful wine which has a great combination of refreshing citrus fruit and peachy flavours.

**Quinta do Vallado Douro** £60

*Portugal* | This wine is a blend of four different indigenous Portuguese grape varieties. It has aromas of ripe melon, and some floral aromas. On the palate this wine is dry, crisp and refreshing.

**Morgassi Superiore Tuffo Gavi** £65

**del Comune di Gavi**

*Italy* | This is a fantastic example of Gavi, with floral aromas and notes of Citrus, Apple and Vanilla.

**Creation Viognie** £70

*South Africa* | This wine has abundant fruit aromas like white peach and apricots and a rich, creamy character too.

**La Chablisienne Chablis Sereine** £75

*France* | This is a rich, slightly buttery style of wine packed with pure fruit flavours of lemons, limes and melons. It has a dry, almost chalky feel in the mouth also. It will be an ideal partner to seafood and grilled fish dishes.

**Neudorf Moutere Pinot Gris** £80

*New Zealand* | It is dry and yet the nose is generous, the palate is plump and rich. Elegant, sculptured and sophisticated. Wild yeast ferment offers fleshiness and total drinkability.

**Mission Hill Reserve Chardonnay** £85

*Canada* | A tremendous balance of texture, acidity, and freshness. Bright apple, lemon, tropical fruit and a hint of baking spice are all balanced with an elegant texture and fresh acidity on the palate.

**Sancerre Les Grands Champs** £90

**Domaine Fouassier**

*France* | The producer is certified Biodynamic and makes wine very naturally. It is a dry, light bodied wine which is very crisp and refreshing. It has flavours of zesty citrus fruit and stone fruit.

## ROSÉ WINES *By the bottle*

**Ultimate Provence** £47.5

**Côtes de Provence**

*France* | Not just a pretty bottle – this is top-quality rosé from some of Provence's best vineyards. Pale pink in colour, it is a delicate and refreshing wine with layers of fragrant raspberry, strawberry and subtle spice.

**Journeys End Wild Child Rose** £37.5

*South Africa* | This rosé is made from the Grenache grape and comes from South Africa. It is crisp and refreshing with flavours of red cherry, raspberry, strawberry and rose petals.

**Wandering Bear Rose** £31

*South Africa* | This rosé is made from the Pinotage grape and comes from South Africa. It is crisp and refreshing with flavours of black cherry, raspberry and watermelon. There is some sweetness to this wine.

## RED WINES *By the bottle*

**Terre Forti Sangiovese** £31

*Italy* | Light and fruity, with cherries, summer fruit notes

**Santa Rita Gran Hacienda Merlot** £37.5

*Chile* | This wine made with merlot grape has flavours of ripe red plums, red and black cherry with a touch of sweet spice. The soft velvety tannins make it easy drinking both with food and without.

**Zensa Primitivo Puglia** £40

*Italy* | Full bodied with rich flavours of Morello cherries, plums, raisins and liquorice.

**Les Roches Beaujolais Villages** £42.5

*France* | This wine is a deep red ruby colour with violet tinges. It smells very expressive with lots of strawberries and raspberries and also some floral aromas.

**Argento Single Vineyard Altamira** £45

**Organic Malbec**

*Argentina* | Malbec makes big, rich and dark wines. The flavours and aromas are plums, dark chocolate and blackberries with some spice and pepper as well. It is made from selected organically grown grapes which are sourced from top organic vineyards.

**Battle of Bosworth Puritan Shiraz** £50

*Australia* | This wine is called 'Puritan' because none of the usual preservatives are used. As a result, this wine, which is made from the Shiraz grape variety, is very fresh. It has intense aromas of dark fruit including blueberries.

**Valdivieso Single Vineyard** £55

**Cabernet Franc**

*Chile* | This is a fairly unusual variety and makes very deeply coloured wines with masses of sweet spice and black fruit with just a hint of liquorice.

**Catena Appellation Vista Flores Malbec** £60

*Argentina* | The grapes used here come from a single vineyard site. The flavours and aromas are plums, dark chocolate and blackberries with some spice and pepper as well.

**Journeys End Single Vineyard Shiraz** £65

*South Africa* | This is a ripe and juicy red wine made from Shiraz. There are aromas of ripe raspberries with a hint of pepper. It is big and powerful with lots of red berries and spicy flavours and a hint of vanilla.

**Vivanco Rioja Reserva** £70

*Spain* | The word "Reserva" on the label indicates that this wine has plenty of ageing in both barrel and in bottle. The principle flavours are strawberries, red cherries and spicy oak with notes of tobacco.

**Xanadu Estate Cabernet Sauvignon** £75

*Australia* | This wine is packed full of aromas and flavours of ripe forest fruits, juicy blackcurrants and dark chocolate. It is full-bodied with a persistent berry fruit finish.

**Neudorf Tom's Block Pinot Noir 2016** £80

*New Zealand* | The nose has a deep and dark winter stone fruit note. The palate is a woven series of dark plum and cloves. Nelson pinot celebrates an underlying umami or savoury note and this is no exception. Nothing is out of balance in this bottle.

**Mission Hill Reserve Merlot** £85

*Canada* | Power and structure dance while lush, round flavours of plum, blackberry, cedar and fig flourish.

**Vieux Chevalier** £90

**Chateauneuf du Pape Rouge**

*France* | This deep red wine is complex and elegant, with aromas of red currants, red cherries and black berries, with spicy overtones such as lavender, thyme and rosemary. The wine shows very subtle oaky notes, bringing complexity and length. With an excellent balance, the tannins are elegant and silky.

# DESSERT WINES

<b>Royal Tokaji Late Harvest,</b>	<i>£7</i>	<i>£33</i>
<i>Tokaj, Hungary 50cl</i>		
This is a sweet dessert wine from Hungary. It is called late harvest because they pick the grapes later when the grapes are riper and sweeter. It has a flowery aroma and to taste it has flavours of fresh tropical fruits, apricot and peach.		
<b>Perle D'arche Sauternes,</b>	<i>£12.5</i>	<i>£35</i>
<i>Bordeaux, France 37.5cl</i>		
Open fruity nose with botrytis and apricot notes twinned with honey flavours. Well balanced in the palate without being overwhelmed by richness. The length is characterised by a fruity and vanilla finish.		

# PORT

<b>Quinta Do Vallado 10 Year Old Tawny</b>	<i>£6</i>
<i>Douro, Portugal</i>   This wine is a brown tawny colour due to extended ageing in barrels instead of bottle. It has rich, nutty aromas with flavours of sweet raisins and dates, spice and mocha.	
<b>Quinta Do Vallado 20 Year Old Tawny</b>	<i>£7</i>
<i>Douro, Portugal</i>   Rich with aromas of prunes, roasted nuts and cigar. The rounded palate ends with a long, silky finish.	
<b>Quinta Do Vallado 30 Year Old Tawny</b>	<i>£8.5</i>
<i>Douro, Portugal</i>   A long process of barrel ageing produces a wine with a pale brown colour, with an intense and complex palate, displaying flavours of fruit cake and tobacco. The finish goes on seamlessly.
